## SPECIALITY AND ACADEMIC CAMPS 9:30 a.m. – 11 a.m.

\*Each Specialty or Academic Camp (except Swimming) will be \$50 per week in addition to regular rates for enrolled campers unless otherwise noted. Swimming is \$75.00 per week. The cost for students coming ONLY to Academic Camps is \$125 per week and these campers will NOT participate in field trips.

### Cooking/Baking

**Grade:** All ages

**Dates Available:** various weeks

**Description:** Join Ms. Valorie as we create yummy cooking creations and learn cooking techniques and simple nutritional concepts.

### Swimming

**Grade:** All ages

**Dates Available:** various weeks

**Description:** Swimming lessons taught by McGinnis Woods' lifeguards. Students should bring swimsuit, goggles, change of clothes and a bag. Parents must sign separate permission slip.

### Digging for Dinosaurs

**Grade:** PK – 8<sup>th</sup>

**Dates Available:** May 28 – May 31

**Description:** Roam with us as we uncover the mystery of ages past. Become a paleontologist by digging for dinosaur bones, studying fossils, and considering how dinosaurs became extinct. We will execute our own fossils to uncover real dinosaur teeth and bones. If you "dig" this, then come join us on a journey through time.

### Jr. Robotics

**Grade:** Rising PK – Rising 2<sup>nd</sup>

**Description:** This camp is a perfect mixture of excitement and learning, using LEGO WeDo Robots. Using LEGO bricks, students follow step by step instructions to build an airplane rescue, a smart spinning top, a goal kicker, and a sailboat storm. Campers will learn how to program and operate their creations using a mini laptop computer

### Sports Sampler
